A) Eligibility for Admission

1. M.Ed. Special Education (Visual Impairment) Programme for the academic session 2017-19

- i. A Candidate who has successfully passed B.Ed. Special Education (Visual Impairment) with minimum 50% marks from a recognized University or any other Degree considered equivalent to B.Ed. Special Education (Visual Impairment) from an affiliating University and/or teaching Department under any University recognized by UGC

or

A candidate who has successfully passed B.Ed. General Education course and has successfully passed two year Diploma in Special Education (Visual Impairment)/ PGPD (VI) recognized by rehabilitation Council of India with minimum 50% marks

2. B.Ed. Special Education (Visual Impairment) Programme for the academic session 2017-19

- i. A Candidate who has successfully passed B.A./B.Com./B.Sc from a recognized University with at least 50% of marks in aggregate

3. D.Ed. Special Education (Visual Impairment) Programme for the academic session 2017-19

- i. At least 50% marks in aggregate in the qualifying examination i.e. (10+2)

4. Post Graduate Diploma in Rehabilitation Psychology

- i. A candidate having studied psychology as one of the main subject at graduate level or a candidate having obtained a post graduate degree in psychology will be eligible for seeking admission in PGDRP.

- 5. Louis Braille Memorial Fellowship:- 02-** Louis Braille Memorial Fellowships for undertaking research in the field of Braille Development and in the development of need based methods and materials for promoting education of children and youth with visual impairment. Fellowship amount: Rs.40,000.00 per month initially for a period of two years extendable by one year.

Eligibility Criterion:

- (a) He/she should be an Indian national residing in India;
- (b) He/she should possess a Master's Degree with not less than 55% of marks in Special Education (V.I.)/Master's Degree in related field;

OR

Ph.D on a topic related to the education, training and rehabilitation of persons with visual impairment.

- (c) 2 Yrs research experience.

GENERAL CONDITIONS FOR LOUIS BRAILLE MEMORIAL FELLOWSHIP

- i Demand Draft of Rs. 100/- (non refundable) drawn in favour of The Director, NIVH, payable at Dehradun must accompany with the application without which the application will not be considered.
- ii. Applications must invariably be accompanied with attested copies of certificates, degrees, mark-sheets, and testimonials in support of qualifications, age and experience and a broad research proposal without which application will not be considered.
- iii. The Director, NIVH reserves the right to award/not to award any or all of the above fellowships without assigning any reason thereof.
